THE POWER OF SURRENDER

Many people struggle with their walk with the Lord because they do not understand the freedom that comes from surrender. This is one of the most powerful internal spiritual attitudes that we can continually develop. It releases us from the power of "self" and enables us to receive the power of the Holy Spirit, if we truly desire to do the Will of God. Do you truly desire that for your life? Many say they do, but don't actually mean it. What they mean is that they want God to bless them and what they want to do, but they are not willing to surrender all their "wants" to the Lord.

Jesus, speaking of Himself, said in Matthew 21:44 that *"Everyone who falls on this stone will be broken to pieces; but on whomever it falls, it will scatter him like dust."* We have a choice, either we fall upon Him in repentance and surrender and allow Him to break the power of self (which often feels like we are being broken to pieces), or eventually He will fall on us in Judgment. Many people have a theology that rejects this as something the God of Love would never do. But Jesus does not share that theology, as He makes clear here. Please consider some other verses like these: 1Cor. 3:10-15, Matt. 25:14-30, Luke 12:42-48.

Only when we understand the power of the Cross to liberate us from the power of self, will we be willing to allow the Lord to do a deep work of "crucifying us with Christ" (Romans chapter 6). Then it is no longer us who live according to the weakness of self, but we now have the opportunity to learn how to live by the power of the indwelling Holy Spirit (Gal. 2:20). As we learn how to allow Him to "mix His life with ours" (Phil 4:13) by surrendering our will, even to the depths of our heart, and not reject or resist, but accept what He does or allows to happen to us, as part of His plan to make us like Himself, we begin to experience what it means to enter into the true freedom and liberty of the "Children of God" (Rom. 8:28-39, 2Cor. 3:18, Col. 3:10, Phil. 2:13).

May the Love, Grace and Mercy of God fill you and empower you to fulfill His will!!
